Margaritaville Cottage & Villa Name Guidelines

Welcome to our little slice of paradise! We're happy to have you as a Property Owner at *Margaritaville®* Resort Orlando. We know you're excited to make your mark here, and one of the best ways of doing that is by naming your Cottage or Villa!

What do Cottage/Villa nameplates look like?

• These professionally produced signs are manufactured to the same standards as your Property's address plaque and are typically mounted just below the address. These nameplates meet all community signage guidelines; there's no worry about them being an unapproved exterior modification (unlike other signage).

How do I pick a name?

- Each Property name must be unique. We check all new requests against existing names. It's first-come, first-named.
- Our *Margaritaville* brand partners approve all Property names at their sole and complete discretion. In our experience, we have found that:
 - Clever "twists" on Jimmy Buffett songs, albums, and lyrics are sometimes approved, but verbatim references to them are typically denied (Example: Cheeseburger Inn was approved, but Cheeseburger in Paradise was denied)
 - o Names including "Five O'clock", "Latitude", or "Fins Up" are consistently denied
 - o It's best to avoid anything that could be considered inappropriate, obscene, or copyrighted
- We suggest you stick to something relatively short, maybe three or four words. The standard nameplates are a fixed size, and longer names may require an additional fee.

OK, I have the perfect name. How do I request it?

- Visit FinsUpBeachClub.com and navigate to Perks & Benefits > Property Name Request.
- To provide consistency and fairness to all Owners, we accept requests only after your real estate closing has occurred.
- We'll submit the name exactly as typed in the form (including punctuation), but please note that the vendor prints the signs in ALL CAPITAL LETTERS and may need to adjust spacing/layout to fit the sign template.

My request has been submitted. Now what?

- Review usually takes around five business days, but it can be longer or shorter. We'll notify you as soon as we hear back.
- We typically order in batches around the end of the month. Payment must be received before your nameplate is ordered.
- Nameplates are typically manufactured and installed within 45 days of the order being placed.
- We'll send you a photo of the nameplate once we've verified that it has been installed and is correct.

How much does this cost? What if the nameplate is damaged or needs to be replaced? What if I change my mind?

- Each nameplate incurs a fee from our sign vendor. All charges are processed by our Membership Department, and we will guide you through the process once your Property's name is approved.
 - o **Standard Nameplates:** Our records show that **the vendor currently charges \$95** (subject to change) for a standard nameplate. This price includes tax, but a small additional fee may apply for some payment methods.
 - Extended Nameplates: It's rare, but some longer names (based on character count and word layout) may require
 a larger nameplate and therefore a higher price. Our records show the price is usually around \$140 (subject to
 change). If this applies to you, we'll ask the vendor to quote an exact price before you commit to purchasing it.
- New owners of a previously owned Property can usually keep an existing nameplate at no charge. You don't need to submit a form to keep the same name (unless the nameplate is damaged/missing and needs to be replaced).
- If you sell one Property and buy another, you may be able to transfer the existing name and nameplate to your new Property at no charge. Contact jackie.steele@encore-fl.com for details (preferably before your old Property sells).
- You're responsible for normal maintenance of your nameplate. If it must be replaced, you'll need to purchase a replacement through us at the manufacturer's prevailing rate.
- Changes or other adjustments after name approval may be subject to additional fees if the vendor has already begun manufacturing the nameplate.
